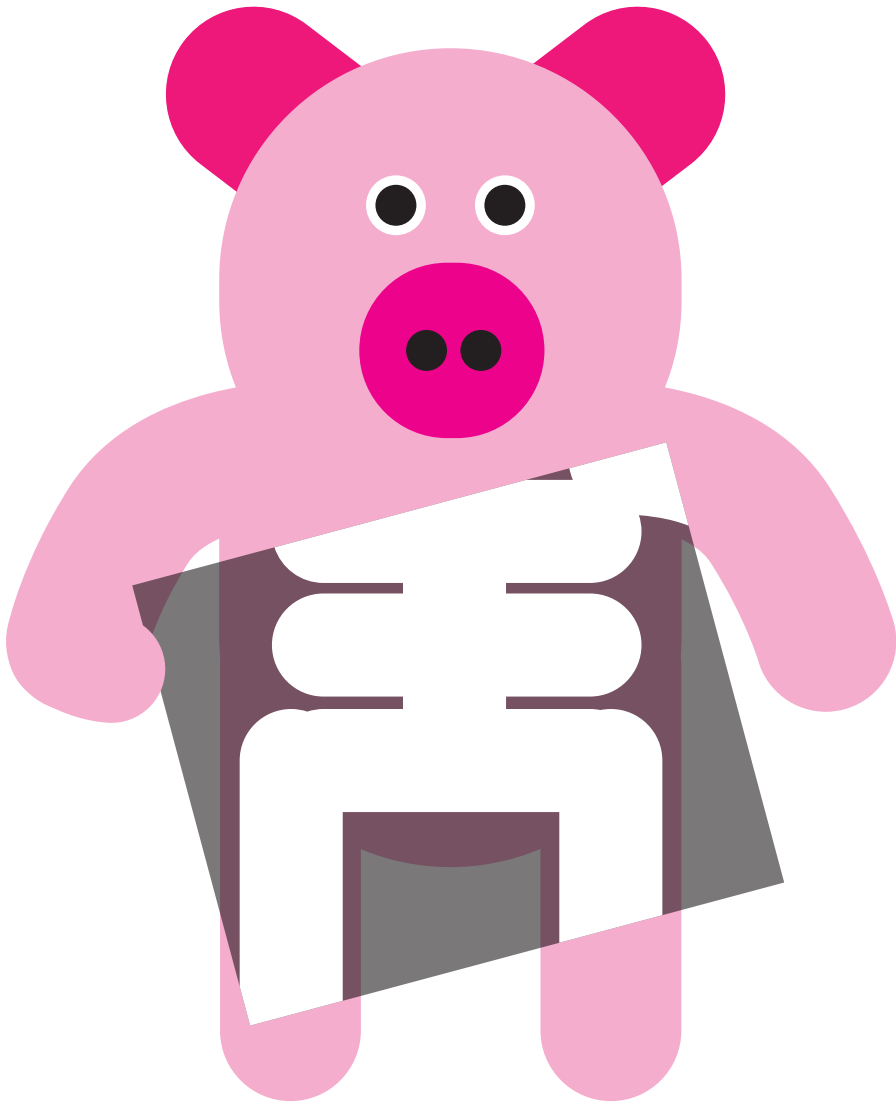
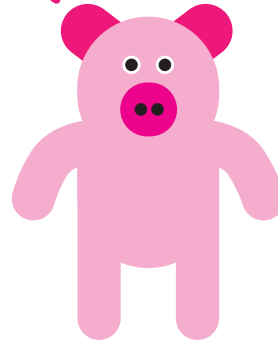

**how to bring your
glovepig to life**

Congratulations on your purchase of an awesome funky glovepig! My name is Carlos and I'll help you get your new friend sewn together in no time at all... so get a brew on and let's make a little piggy.



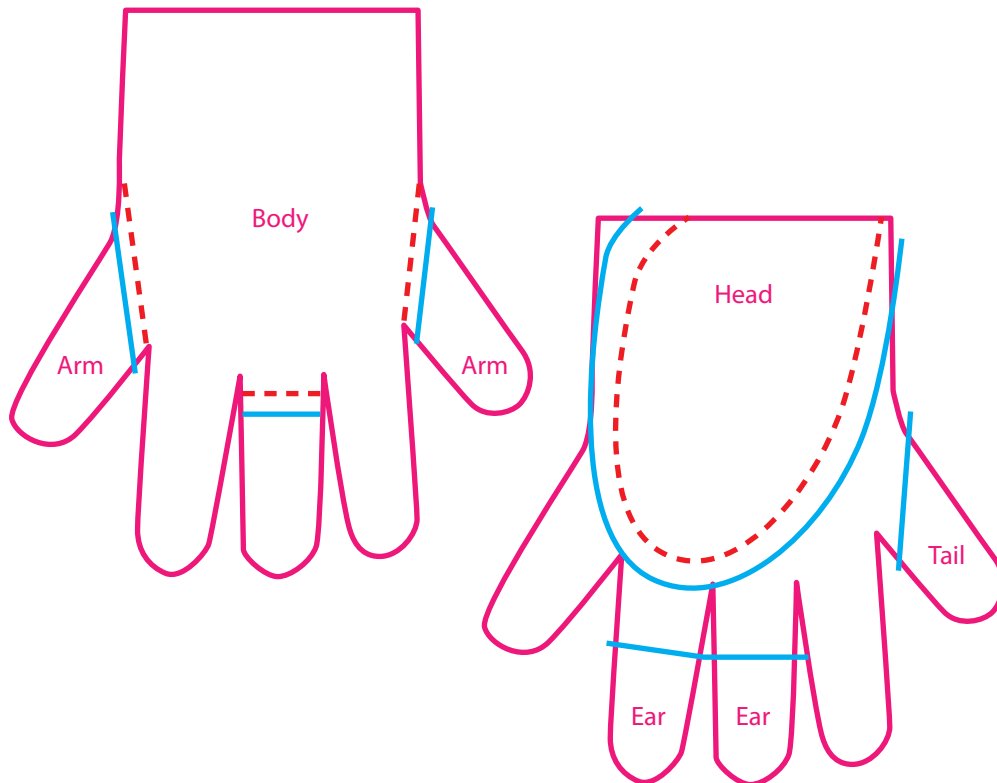
step 1

Lay out the contents of your bag of stuff in front of you. You should have:

- Two gloves
- A Needle
- Thread
- A button for the nose
- Beads for eyes
- Stuffing
- A heart (made of felt)

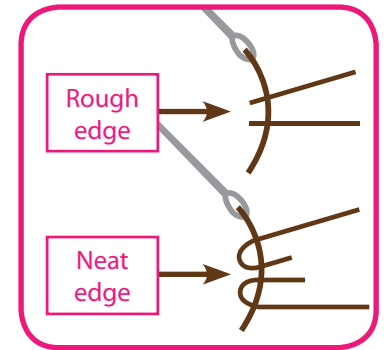
step 2

Turn the gloves inside out and lay them in front of you like below. The left glove will be the 'Body' of your glovepig, and the right sock will be the 'bits'; its head, tail and ears. Sew up the lines marked ■ ■ and then once you are done, leaving a 5mm margin cut the lines marked with ■.



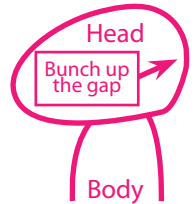
step 3

Turn the 'Body' glove the right-way out and push stuffing into the glove (remembering half way to add the heart) and start to see your pig take shape. You then need to sew up the hole so the stuffing doesn't all come out, as you do this bunch the gap together and this will form the neck. Use small stitches and fold the edge to get a neater edge (See diagram to the right).



step 4

Turn the body parts right-way out and fill them with stuffing. Take the head and bunch up the back like you did in step 3 and form a head shape. Attach the head and arms onto the body and see your glovepig come to life!

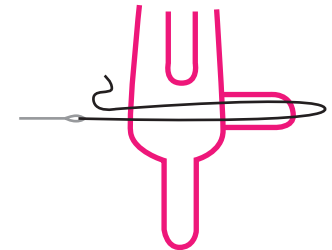


step 5

Now position the ears where you want them, sew on the bead eyes and also the button nose.

step 6

Finally you just need to add the tail. Sew it on where looks best. To make the tail curly you now need to poke the needle and thread starting where his belly button would be, thread straight through out of the back of the tail, and then back through again (see diagram to the right). As you then tie a knot at the belly button it will crinkle up the tail making your little piggy complete.



step 7

Now your glovepig is complete! Remember to fill out his birth certificate. Take good care of your little pig and he will bring you a lifetime of fun. If they get dirty don't worry (as they do dribble their food and love playing in mud), just wash them by hand and leave them somewhere cosy warm to dry.

Remember that although I am a friendly creature I may not be suitable for young children as they may damage me and choke on my leg or something nasty like that.
