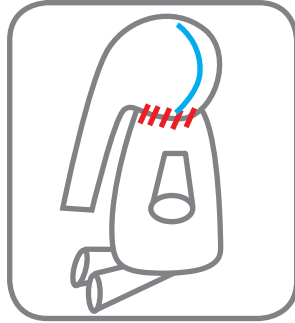


### step 8

Position the head onto the body and stitch them together.

### step 9

Take the ears at stitch them onto the head. Stitch them on a curved line as illustrated with the blue line on the right.



### step 10

Flip your sockelephant over onto its tummy and attach the tail.

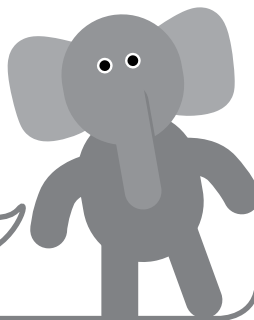
### step 11

Position the eyes where you think best and sew them on too.

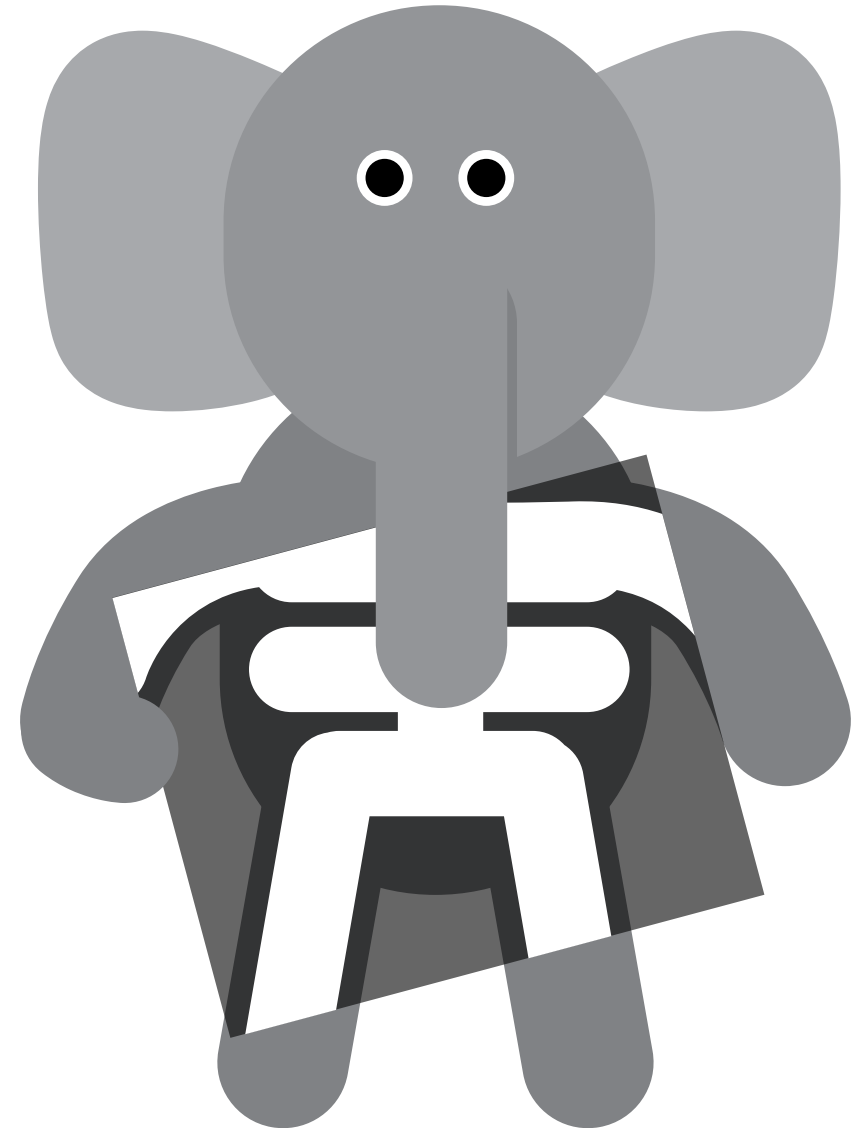
### step 12

Now your sockelephant is complete! Remember to fill out his birth certificate. Take good care of your elephant and he will bring you a lifetime of fun. If they get dirty don't worry (as they do dribble their food and love playing in mud), just wash them by hand and leave them somewhere cosy warm to dry.

Remember that although I am a friendly creature I may not be suitable for young children as they may damage me and choke on my leg or something nasty like that.

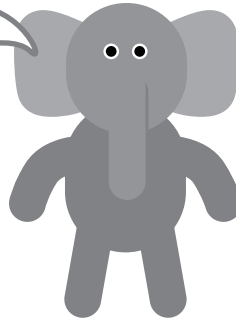

# how to bring your sockelephant to life

**Congratulations on your purchase of a fantastic sockelephant! My name is Sanchez and I'll help you get your new friend sewn together in no time at all... so get a brew on and let's make an elephant.**



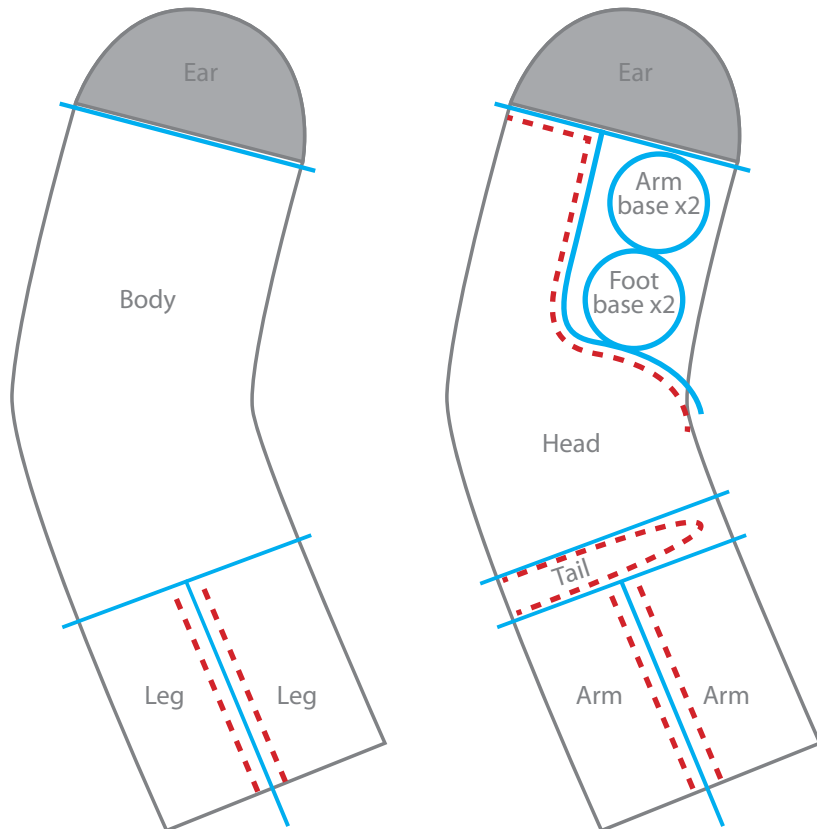
### step 1

Lay out the contents of your bag of stuff in front of you. You should have:

- Two socks
- A Needle
- Thread
- Buttons for eyes
- Stuffing
- A heart (made of felt)

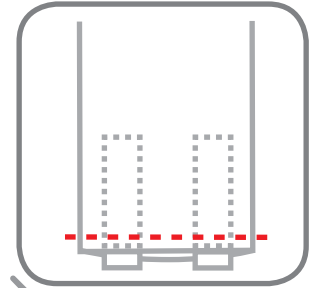
### step 2

Turn the socks inside out and lay them in front of you like below. The left sock will be the body, legs and one ear of your sockelephant, and the right sock will be the arms, head, other ear and tail. Sew up the lines marked ■ ■ and then once you are done, leaving a 5mm margin cut the lines marked with ■.



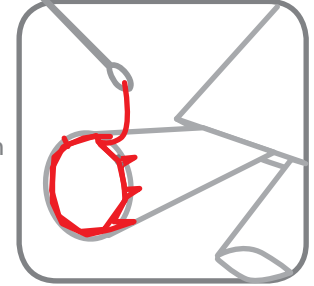
### step 3

Keep the 'body' inside out but lay it so that the heel is flat at the back. Turn the legs the right way around. Position them inside the body with just a little sticking out of the bottom like the diagram on the right. Then stitch along the section marked ■ ■.



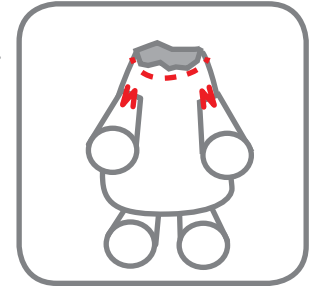
### step 4

Now when you turn the body the right way round and you should have a body with legs sticking out of the bottom. Fill the legs with some stuffing. Take one of the circles ('bases') you cut out of the right sock and position it over the hole at the 'foot' of the leg. Using blanket stitch seal the base onto the leg so it looks like the picture on the right. Do the same with the other leg.



### step 5

Similarly to step 4 attach the arm bases to the arms using blanket stitch. Stuff them and position them on the body. Stitch them on.



### step 6

Stuff the body and start to see your sockelephant taking shape. Gather up the top of the body and use some thread to keep it in position. This will form the neck.

### step 7

Take the 'Head' piece you cut out earlier and turn it the right way round. Fill it with stuffing and turn it so the trunk is facing away from you. What you now need to do is gather the open end and fold it and stitch it like the diagram on the right.
